Preface/Definitions

CHAPTER A: Name - Headquarters - Principles - Purpose - Structure

Article 1 - Name, distinctive title, registered office and identity

1.1. The non-profit Association is founded in Athens, Attica under the name "Intersex Greece - Hellenic Intersex Community", with the distinctive title "Intersex Greece" and / or briefly with the acronym "Inter-gr", based in Athens,, .. (headquarters address, PC), in the Attica Region, and hereinafter referred to as "Association".

1.2. By decision of the General Assembly, branches of the Association may be established in other cities, anywhere in Greece (see article...).

1.3. The Association is a non-profit legal entity under private law (NPID) and is governed by the following statutory terms and agreements, contained in these statutes and the provisions of articles 78 to 106 of the Civil Code.

1.4. The main emblem of the Association consists of a semicircle in the colors of the international intersex flag (purple and yellow) presented under the title of this statute, supplemented by the name of the Association.

1.5. The seal of the Association is circular - in the circumference of the circle the full name of the Association is mentioned (Intersex Greece - Hellenic Intersex Community) and in the center is an orchid, as an international symbol of intersex people.

1.6. The Association is a non-governmental organization: The members who participate in the Board of Directors of the center and the local branches are obliged not to be registered in governmental or party organizations or to abstain from the right to be elected in them or in related activities, except for professional relationships.

1.7. The Association is a voluntary and non-profit organization. Its unpaid services are provided by the members of the Association voluntarily. The paid services are not intended to collect own revenues, but are used to cover basic and operational needs of the Association. No member is paid for their services to the Association.

Article 2 - Values, Aims, Objectives and Means

2.1. The Values running through the aims, objectives and means of the Association are:

- Inclusion: We seek to give our members a safe space, a sense of "belonging" and the development of a common "code" of communication to support the security, independence, solidarity and confidence of all. All our members are included equally, without discrimination of race, color, sex, gender identity, sex characteristics, gender expression, sexual orientation, disability, spirituality, origin, nationality, professional or financial status.
- Citizenship: We participate in political and social issues in Greece and in the world, focusing on political and social structures of shaping opinions or decision-making in relation to intersex (in particular) and LGBTQI (in general) rights, contributing to the creation and preservation of a democratic life, with respect for human rights.
- Cooperation: We want dialogue and cooperation with other civil society organizations, with institutions and independent authorities, always with the aim of promoting the interests of intersex & human rights, for every human being.

- Democracy: As members of a Civil Society organization, we strive every day to put into practice the democratic principles on which we build the way the Greek Intersex Community operates.
- Sustainability: We recognize our responsibility to society and the environment, the ethical principle of equal rights between present and future generations. Recognizing that we are "passers-by" from planet Earth, we want to make sure that the next generations enjoy it whole and functional.

2.2. The aims of the Association are

- the legal recognition of the rights of intersex people
- the explicit prohibition of non-medically necessary medical interventions on the bodies of intersex people, without their prior informed consent
- the equal inclusion of intersex people in every level of life and society

2.3. Without in any way limiting or derogating from the inherent powers of the organisation, the objects of the company are to:

1. The promotion and support of equality, inclusion and fundamental rights and freedoms and equal treatment in the Greek territory of intersex persons.
2. The abolition of discrimination based on sex, gender expression, gender identity and sex characteristics, in accordance with the principles derived from the Greek Constitution, the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union, the European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR), the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR), the Yogyakarta Principles and the European and as they are specialized in International Intersex Declarations (Malta, Riga, Darlington, Vienna).

3. The development of solidarity and mutual assistance between intersex persons, and the organizing and supporting of actions aimed at disseminating the aims of the Association. Support and empower intersex individuals and their families including the use of online forums, social activities, events and personal meetings.
4. provide information, education, training and counseling on issues relating to the somatic physiology, the wellbeing and the human rights of intersex people, including through the internet, printed or audio-visual material, art events and face to face meetings;
5. build and expand the visibility, support and awareness of Greek citizens on intersex issues in every field of life (legal recognition, education, labor, health and health care, society) with respect for human and children rights and legal protection of intersex people and their needed services;
6. develop of diverse leadership, reflective of our diverse community and special care to develop and nurture intersex youth advocates;
7. lead and contribute to the process of policy making towards the protection of the rights and the equal inclusion of intersex people;
8. develop plans and actions focused on healing trauma and reparative justice for intersex people;
9. raising and advancing an intersex-inclusive and intersex-affirming language
10. engage and partner with other national, european and international organisations that share common goals with the organisation;
11. raise, apply and channel financial and other resources to support the initiatives, programs and priorities of the organisation, including European-funded projects;

12. The creation of a hostel for housing and feeding and generally the support of intersex people who are disabled due to their social exclusion, as well as gays, lesbians, bisexuals, transgender / trans, racial, non-binary and intersex applicants for international protection and.
13. The legal, psychological and moral support of intersex persons, as well as the possibility of appealing to the Justice of the Association or before any Administrative or Independent Authority, European or International Organization or Court for the protection of their rights and freedoms.
14. The linking of the relevant domestic actions with those of foreign countries as well as with other non-governmental domestic organizations with action for the rights of gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, intersex, racial and non-bisexual persons.
15. The performance of any other lawful functions and purposes that are necessary or ancillary to the objects and the achievement of the objectives mentioned above.

2.4. Means

The pursuit of the goals of the Association is done by any appropriate legal means, such as lectures, seminars, research, circulation of newsletters and brochures, production of radio and television shows, publications, club operations, performances at Authorities, attending seminars, art seminars and educational events, setting up advisory or scientific committees, organizing workshops and conferences, collaborations with wider associations, bodies and other collectives, contact and cooperation with educational institutions, operation of websites, forums and pages on social networks, participation in European programs, etc.

Article 3 - Operating Structure of the Association

3.1. The overall work of the Association is undertaken by separate "Work Sectors" which have a specific theme and specialized role and purpose of operation, and are described in detail in the Regulation of Internal Operation (KEL). Each Work Sector has one elected coordinator / member of the Board, and has the ability according to KEL to appoint individual project teams per sector, according to the goals and objectives of this Statute. The Sectors must cooperate to promote the aims and achieve the goals of the Association.

3.2. The Association is based entirely on the volunteerism of its members. Members are divided into 4 circles based on their degree of involvement and involvement in decision-making and implementation: Member's Base, Volunteers / Partners, Plenary and Board of Directors. The circles of the members are described in detail in the Regulation of Internal Operation. Starting from the Base, members can be further activated as Volunteers and then move on to the internal management circles of the Association: in Plenary and (through elections by the General Assembly) to the Board of Directors.
